I refer to the Transport and Resources Committee Report No. 12 – *Vehicle Safety, Standards and Technology, Including Engine Immobiliser Technology* which was tabled on 24 September 2021.

Among the Committee's seven recommendations was that I reconsider the proposed changes to the written-off vehicle scheme.

To reconsider the proposed changes, and provide a considered response to the Legislative Assembly, the matters raised in the Committee's report will require a detailed and thorough examination.
