An Act authorising the Treasurer to pay amounts from the consolidated fund for departments for the financial years starting 1 July 2019 and 1 July 2020

The Parliament of Queensland enacts—

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (COVID-19) Act 2020*.

Note—

Under the *Financial Accountability Act 2009*, section 5, words used in this Act that are defined under the *Financial Accountability Act 2009* have the same meaning the words have in that Act, subject to a contrary intention in this Act.

2 Supplementary appropriation for 2019–2020

- (1) The Treasurer is authorised to pay \$3,181,010,000 from the consolidated fund for the financial year starting 1 July 2019.
- (2) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) is appropriated for the financial year for Queensland Treasury for application to its administered items.
- (3) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) is in addition to the amount of \$54,698,900,000 already authorised by the *Appropriation Act 2019*, section 2, to be issued from the consolidated fund for departments for the financial year starting 1 July 2019.

3 Further supply for 2020–2021

- (1) The Treasurer is authorised to pay \$1,614,800,000 from the consolidated fund for departments for the financial year starting 1 July 2020.
- (2) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) is in addition to the amount of \$27,349,450,000 already authorised by the *Appropriation Act 2019*, section 3, to be issued from the consolidated fund for departments for the financial year starting 1 July 2020.
