An Act authorising the Treasurer to pay amounts from the consolidated fund for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service for the financial years starting 1 July 2022 and 1 July 2023

The Parliament of Queensland enacts—

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Parliament) Act* 2022.

Note—

Under the *Financial Accountability Act 2009*, section 5, words used in this Act that are defined under the *Financial Accountability Act 2009* have the same meaning the words have in that Act, subject to a contrary intention in this Act.

2 Appropriation for 2022–2023

- (1) The Treasurer is authorised to pay \$146,721,000 from the consolidated fund for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service for the financial year starting 1 July 2022.
- (2) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) is appropriated for the financial year for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service for application to its departmental services, equity adjustment and administered items as stated in schedule 1.
- (3) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) includes the amount already authorised by the *Appropriation (Parliament) Act* 2021, section 3, to be paid for the financial year starting 1 July 2022.

3 Supply for 2023–2024

The Treasurer is authorised to pay \$73,361,000 from the consolidated fund for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service for the financial year starting 1 July 2023.

4 Repeals

The following Acts are repealed—

- Appropriation (Parliament) Act 2020, No. 36
- Appropriation (Parliament) (2020–2021) Act 2021, No. 1.
