Statement of Compatibility

Prepared in accordance with Part 3 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*

In accordance with section 38 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*, I, the Honourable Mick de Brenni MP, Minister for Energy and Clean Economy Jobs, make this statement of compatibility with respect to the amendments to be moved during consideration in detail (the amendments) for the Clean Economy Jobs Bill 2024.

In my opinion, the amendments to the Bill are compatible with the human rights protected by the *Human Rights Act 2019*. I base my opinion on the reasons outlined in this statement.

Overview of the amendments

The amendments will:

- require review of the 2030 emissions reduction target by 31 December 2025
- require public consultation to be undertaken when making emissions reduction plans
- clarify that the Clean Economy Expert Panel may consult with any persons in the course of preparing its advice.

Human Rights Issues

Human rights relevant to the amendments to the Bill (Part 2, Division 2 and 3 *Human Rights Act 2019*)

I have considered each of the rights protected by part 2 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*. In my opinion, the amendments do not raise any additional human rights considerations under the *Human Rights Act 2019*.

Conclusion

In my opinion, the amendments are compatible with human rights under the *Human Rights Act 2019*.
