It was with much anticipation that I awaited the release of amendments to the Nature Conservation Act 1992 and the subsequent vegetation laws following the damaging amendments that hopefully we never see the likes of again and welcome your amendments.

However the sole objective of the Act should be the conservation of nature it of my opinion that including Section 17 of the Nature Conservation Act would reinstate the integrity of the Cardinal Principal so the management of National Parks as it was and was an election commitment of your Government would restore my confidence in your direction. Also the reinstatement of Wilderness Areas, World Heritage Management Areas, International Agreement Area and Co-ordinated Conservation Areas all play a pivotal role in maintaining a range of protected areas that are acknowledged throughout the world and established by the International Union for the Conservation of Nature.

Section 35(1)(a) of the Nature Conservation Act 2013 referring to the development of Tourist Parks inside National Parks should be removed from the legislation.

I ask that the Committee consider my extensions to your welcome relevant amendments to satisfy my confidence in the amendments.
