My name is John Taylor and I am located at [REDACTED] in Queensland. I have been an owner and breeder of thoroughbreds for over 30 years. I am apposed to the Integrity Bill and I ask that it be scrapped.

The concept of "one standard fits all" can only be applied if the intention is to eliminate a significant section of country racing. There is nothing to protect race clubs from vindictive action by The Integrity Commission or its staff. There is evidence of this type of action since the sacking of all racing boards in June 2015 with the inference that it has been done to reduce, if not eliminate country racing.

Please rethink or withdraw the bill.
