I support the proposal for the following reasons:

At this moment, I am not sure if the sale of the Blair Athol mine for \$1.00, to Linc Energy has been processed or not, but it certainly is obvious that this proposal is designed to avoid further costs to the company particularly regarding rehabilitation of the site.

I am very encouraged by the retrospectivity of the proposed legislative amendment to the bill.

I have heard Jim Pearce (ALP State member for Mirani) state that there are currently 15,000 unrehabilitated mine sites in Queensland.
