LETTER OF SUPPORT – PARLIAMENTARY COMMITTEE – ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (CHAIN OF RESPONSIBILTY) AMENDMENT BILL 2016

Thank you for the opportunity to provide a submission to the Agriculture and Environment Committee on the *Environment Protection (Chain of Responsibility) Bill* 2016 (herein referred to as 'the Bill').

Mackay Regional Council supports the intent of the Bill for increased transparency of responsibilities, ensuring relevant environment obligations are compiled with and reducing financial burdens on the State and Local Governments.

In the Mackay Regional Council Local Government Area, and greater Mackay, Isaac & Whitsunday Region, large scale developments requiring an Environmental Authority (EA) from the Department of Environment and Heritage Protection (DEHP) to minimise environmental harm are not uncommon.

Under the current regime, in the event where environmental protection and/or rehabilitation is not undertaken by an operator, Mackay Regional Council is conscious of the potential long term detrimental effects that may arise within a region while responsibilities and financial matters are resolved at a State level. For example, detrimental impacts may be on the immediate environment (i.e. local waterways health) and visual amenity (i.e. tourism and liveability).

We welcome further opportunity to discuss the Bill and the findings of the parliamentary committee's public consultation findings.
