I wish to comment on the proposed legislation "Animal Management (Protecting Puppies) and Other Legislation Bill 2016".

In addition to the proposed mandatory breeder ID tracking system, I would like to see the following, to end puppy farming cruelty:

- \* Regular health checks for all breeding dogs and puppies before sale
- \* capping litter numbers so that females are not constantly pregnant
- \* mandatory desexing for puppies sold
- \* adequate housing, space, exercise, kind human contact
- \* mandatory record keeping
- \* no exemptions for working dogs
- \* revoke permits of anyone guilty of animal welfare offences, give a financial penalty and remove all animals to safe places
- \* only pets to be sold in pet shops to come from rescue groups or registered and approved breeders

Labor stated it would end cruel puppy farming. As a voter, I want my government to ensure that puppy farms are outlawed and dogs protected.
