We object to the Category C on due to taking away rights in managing that vegetation. Total area of both lots combined is 107 hectares.

We originally completed a farm forestry course at Gympie DPI soon after purchasing the property which we purchased in 1995.

We currently grow 30,000 spotted gum trees under Farm Forestry Management System (planted 1997).

We also currently run 20 head registered Charolais purebred beef cattle.

The land has been sectioned into fencing paddocks for control of land management.

The land in contains high growth lantana and needs expensive weed control and proper management which will not be achieved by over governing land owners properties. This has the effect of stifling and paralysing peoples capacity to manage their property.

These two lots have previously been mined and explored and have rocky outcrops. Also they have been previously logged with tree stumps and dead trees covering the lots in parts.

These amendments to land management are both emotionally damaging and morale busting.

This also has the effect of devaluing our property.

Due to this we cannot see the point in improving our property further.

Had these laws been in place at the time of purchase we would not have proceeded with the purchase.
