Submission to Committee on Vegetation Management (Reinstatement) and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2016

I am a concerned Sunshine Coast resident. I am also a member of the Save the Steve Irwin Way Forest group, but this submission is a personal one.

Queensland's environmental laws are already inadequate and it is imperative that this government achieve greater protection for native forests and the environment.
