## Submission - Waste Reduction and Recycling Bill 2012

The Association thanks the Queensland Parliament for the opportunity to comment on the *Waste Reduction and Recycling Bill 2012.* The contents of the Bill have been reviewed and the following comments are made:

Waste Reduction and Recycling Act 2011 amendments:

- > The Association supports the repeal of the industry waste levy and the associated provisions in the Act.
- > The removal of the provision to require weighbridges at sites receiving less than 10,000 tonnes of waste pre annum is supported.
- Removal of the "deeming table" is supported as this created significant angst amongst council officers who were required to implement the table at the gate of waste facilities.
- > An extension to the date for submission of waste management plans is supported.
- ➤ The Association will work with Environment and Heritage Protection officers to determine appropriate data reporting timeframes as per page 5 of the Explanatory Notes.

## Coastal Protection and Management Act 1995 amendments:

- The process undertaken by the Department of Environment and Heritage Protection to review the relevant Integrated Development Assessment System (IDAS) triggers is commended by the LGAQ.
- ➤ The Association supports the reduction of IDAS triggers associated with the Coastal Protection and Management Act 1995.
- > The Association requests that timely advice to local government and the development industry alike is provided which outlines the changes to the IDAS triggers in a comprehensive way.



Environmental Protection (Greentape Reduction) and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2012:

> The Association is satisfied with these transitional provisions and minor drafting and administrative changes.
