As a concerned citizen I wish to request the parliament to extend the time available for consultation on the QLD COMMUNITY SAFETY BILL 2024, to allow stakeholders and citizens alike proper time to go through it, analyse it, and put together a detailed and extensive submission. Areas of the bill which cause major concern as a responsible firearms owner, relate to changes in the Fit & Proper Person criteria and the issuance of Firearms Prohibition Orders (FPOs), as well as the provisions for the police to order social media content taken down which might involve firearms. This bill aims to criminalise responsible firearms license holders and is a breach of our rights as law-abiding Australian citizens.
