I do not agree with the current Queensland Community safety bill which is being rushed through. There is not nearly enough time for people to properly go through it and put a proper submission together. I believe the submission period MUST be delayed to allow Queenslanders a proper chance to consider the Bill. There are too many changes being proposed and will have serious consequences on law abiding people and firearm license holders. I am particularly concerned with the firearms prohibition order changes. The definitions are way too broad and can lead to unfair and unreasonable consequences to law abiding innocent individuals. The public places definitions are also way too broad and will lead to confusion and unfair penalties on ordinary activities. This bill needs to be reconsidered and time given to allow for proper dialogue with stakeholders and Queenslanders.
