While generally favourable there are a number of areas of concern. This is particularly in terminology.

(b) the appointment of persons as SES chief officer, local controllers, SES commanders and other SES members;

Replace the term commander with co-ordinator which better describes the role and is consistent with the current legislation. Do this in all places this term appears.

(b) the local government for the local government area agrees to the establishment of an SES unit for the local government area.

## 26 SES commanders

Term should be changed to co-ordinator and should only be for disasters as per the current legislation.

## 48 Exemption from toll

- (1) This section applies if—
- (a) an SES member is travelling in an SES vehicle in the person's capacity as an SES member; and
- (b) the SES vehicle is fitted with a warning device or warning light that is activated.
- (2) The SES member is exempt from payment of a toll for the use by the member and the SES vehicle of a road, bridge or ferry.
