My name is [REDACTED] and I previously lived at [REDACTED]. I am happy for my submission including my name to be public.

I previously lived in [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] and was kicked out. [REDACTED] has taken a number of my personal items and stolen my property.

I have a number of other concerns regarding [REDACTED].

The sloped driveway is not accessible and there are a number of people with mobility issues and in wheelchairs, I don't believe this is appropriate.

Further to this, when there are issues at the property, including items being stolen, people arguing etc, the police are never called. I believe they should be called.

The meals are unfit, some food is not cooked properly and it is not quality food.

I was paying them \$410 per week which I believe was excessive for what I was receiving, a room and basic food.

The food is high in sugar content and so many people have put on weight since living there.

I think this all needs to be looked into and things need to change.
