My name is [REDACTED]. My live at [REDACTED] and the reason why I'm putting in this submission is because I believe that supported accommodation needs to be addressed more properly. I want my name confidential, but I want my submission public.

The reason my supported accommodation needs to be supported and improved is because we live in these places and we want the government to listen and basically I want them to hear us out. I don't want to hear their ideas, but I want to them to hear us out. Like in every other place in Brisbane, residents feel that their self is excluded. They're not allowed to say stuff. They live in fear of eviction every day and some people just don't take their meds. Do damage to themselves. Then end up in hospital on a ventilator. I've been here for 30 years and I've seen people do far worse things.
