I wish to object to the Queensland Government extending its Emergency Powers. Queensland has been greatly afflicted by these emergency powers for long enough. We are now in an endemic stage of the virus and more than 90% of the population is vaccinated. It is unreasonable & disproportionate to allow the government to extend emergency powers which are written into legislation for short term emergencies not for extended periods of time being 2 plus years.
