Dear CSSC,

Please do not extend the emergency powers due to the following reasons:

- Broad vaccine mandates in QLD are inconsistent with Commonwealth Law;
- Broad vaccine mandates in QLD are inconsistent with EU and UK health regulations;
- Vaccine mandates segregate society and cause more social harm than benefit over time, including mental health;
- There is no informed consent when Qld Health does not disclose detailed surveillance reports by age, vaccine status and comorbidities;
- Trust in public health is failing when full data is not disclosed to the public with transparency to correlate how the vaccine mandates address proportional risks of transmission in all aged groups and morbidities
- Trust in public health is failing when I have lodged a "Right to Information" form to Qld Health, however ignored for weeks now highlighting political manipulation and corruption;
- Omicron severity is correlated at least by x300 by age/existing health condition, compared to x1.5 by vaccination status amongst young and healthy (0.3 in 100,000 is not an emergency risk) based on UK surveillance data. Therefore, the vaccine mandates unreasonably segregate the healthy and youth, which is not proportional to the risks.
- The median age of death from Covid is 82 years compared to the average life expectancy of 82-83 years, therefore this is a "pandemic of the sick and elderly" and not a "pandemic of the unvaccinated". To hide this fact is propaganda and corrupt.
- The vaccine mandates are ultimately not proportional to the risks, and any marginal benefits of vaccines to young and healthy does not outweigh the social harm caused with segregation and loss of Human Rights towards medical procedures.

If the emergency powers are accepted, it would not be regarded just, proportional, reasonable or fair to leave broad vaccine mandates powers in place for every aged group.

The State Government should not be allowed to abuse their emergency powers to bully anyone young and healthy into getting a vaccine unless by freedom of choice and full Human Rights.

The unvaccinated are not being encouraged to get vaccinated from these mandates, conversely, they are getting angrier, depressed, distrustful of the government and not

spending money in retail, travel and hospitality.
