To Whom it may concern,

I would like to state that I DO NOT agree to an Extension to the Emergency Bill (until 31st October 2022).

The extension of powers is based on COVID deaths in Queensland and COVID numbers. The Australian Bureau of Statistics data is now showing exaggeration of such data, with only 83 deaths in 2 two years of people with no pre-existing comorbidities. More people have died as a result of suicide from the mandates that have been forced upon us, along with many, many more from cancer, heart disease and diabetes.

At present, I am unable to work due to my medical status, I have seen people die and young men injured as a response to the COVID vaccines. I am a mother of 3 and am unwilling to take a risk of vaccine injury with the current COVID Omicron is no more serious than the flu.
