My name is Rebecca Yarwood and I'm respectfully writing to object to extending the, Emergency Provisions'. I do NOT want this.

Bill I object to: Public health and other legislation (extension of expiring provisions) Amendment bill 2022

Evidence:

The extension of powers is based on COVID deaths in QLD and COVID numbers. The ABS data is now showing the exaggeration of such data.

While all deaths including COVID deaths are tragic, the latest statistics from the Australian Bureau of Statistics show that 2,639 people died of COVID and 92% of these people had three serious underlining health conditions. The median age of COVID deaths was 82 for men and 86 for women. (Both above our national life span) More people have died from the flue in 1 year than COVID in 22 months.

Personal Reflection:

My personal reflection living in QLD is that the mandates have done more harm that good to both Vaccinated and unvaccinated. Small businesses have closed down. The stress and mental health problem it has brought on my own life and others. Families and friends are at odds with each other. There is separation and segregation. My question is what has and is being done to measure the quality of mental health. It has affected schools and hospitals putting pressure on staff as they deal with being short staffed.
