Dear Committee Secretary,

Please stop the (Extension of Expiring Provisions) Amendment Bill 2022.

Also, may I please know why they are wanting to extend the Bill to 31 October 2022, when Public Emergency can only be extended for three months.

The PCR and Rapid Antigen Tests are not the best tools to identify COVID-19 disease and keep resulting to false-positive.

Also, I have sent Notices to CHO and Health Minister to provide irrefutable evidence of the existence of COVID-19 virus and its variants, but no one provided an adequate response.

Further, government ABS.gov.au data released on 25 February 2022, shows that in year 2021, there are 136,800 deaths in Australia, with 1,229 deaths due to underlying cause of COVID-19.

Australia with the latest total population of 25,739,256 and a total death of 1,229 for year 2021 concludes COVID-19 disease to have a survival rate of 99.99%.

Since the start of the recorded pandemic from March 2020 to January 2022, there is a total of 2,556 registered deaths due to COVID-19, but only 8.6% (220 deaths) has 'Reported alone on certificate', the remaining 91.4% had 'other diseases and conditions certified' on the death certificate.

From March 2020 to January 2022, 10 female between 0-39 years old died due to COVID-19, but there was no mention if there was any associated cause of death. Out of 6,662,605 female age 0-39 years old in 2021, and an approximate death of 10 female due to COVID-19, I can say that a healthy woman, in my age bracket with no pre-existing medical conditions has 99.99% chance of surviving the COVID-19 disease.

The median age for those who died from COVID-19 was 86.0 years for females.

It also stated that in 2020, there was a decrease in mortality in Australia. It is clear that despite COVID-19, the number of deaths in 2020 declined instead of rising as one would expect in the case of a declared pandemic.

TGA.gov.au data shows that there were 760 reported death as a result of taking the COVID-19 vaccines since it got administered in Australia up to January 2022.
