To whom it may concern,

I am writing to you to inform you that I DO NOT support the extension to the Emergency Bill.

According to the recent ABS data released, the number of COVID deaths in Queensland and threat to life is FAR lower than it was ever predicted.

Since COVID began 22 months ago there have been deaths. Any death is very sad, and my heart goes out to the families who have lost loved ones. However of the 2639 COVID deaths, 92 per cent of these patients had 3 or more serious underlying health conditions. Some 100,000 people died of cancer, 32,000 of heart disease and 10,000 of diabetes... just to name a few health related deaths.

Mandates (mask and vaccination) and lock downs have caused irreparable damage to small and large businesses, they have directly contributed to suicides and placed many people in financial hardship, not to mention the emotional effect on relationships and families.
