I am writing to request an end to the Emergency Bill in Qld. I believe that you are looking at an extension of the current emergency bill until 31 Oct 2022 and that this is based on current COVID case numbers and deaths. Case numbers are not excessive, and the ABS has shown that cases are being exaggerated as there has been no distinction for numbers dying with COVID but the cause of death is something completely separate – like terminal cancer- and those dying of COVID. The current numbers simply don't support the way the state is being crippled through loss of doctors, nurses, disability workers and education staff due to unreasonable mandates. All of these people were considered heroes when they worked through the initial COVID crisis and now they have been told that despite severe staff shortages, they are not welcome at work. Children are being traumatized by the ongoing restrictions and it is time for them to end, and for life to return to normal. COVID as it exists now, seems to be largely a flu and not the deadly disease that it was initially. Please consider this request and restore people's lives and livelihoods.
