My name is Brett Meekcoms. I am a high school teacher in FNQ.

I strongly believe the extension to the emergency bill is unwarranted and unjust.

The extension of powers is based on COVID deaths in Queensland and COVID numbers. The ABS data is now showing the exaggeration of such data. It is also based on hypothetical scenarios which have not been to the extent in which the government has stated on previous occasions. It also directly violates the human rights of the people of Queensland.
