Good evening -

I am writing to request that you please DO NOT extend the Emergency Bill until October 31, 2022

There are many reasons why I believe this, including -

- The number of people in our QLD community who are being discriminated against. People who are choosing not to be vaccinated are not against vaccines per se, they are often against how this has been implemented. And as the vaccines are mandated in many areas - teaching, health, police etc, the Government has taken away the right of human beings to make a choice and this is not fair and links in to Human Rights.
- The anti-discrimination ACT in QLD <https://www.legislation.qld.gov.au/view/whole/html/inforce/current/act-1991-085> also states that people are not to be discriminated against and it appears the Government and also employers are discriminating when it comes to vaccination status.
- People are dying from the vaccine. As identified on the TGA website - <https://www.tga.gov.au/periodic/covid-19-vaccine-weekly-safety-report-24-02-2022> - "*Since the beginning of the vaccine rollout to 20 February 2022, about 53.3 million doses of COVID-19 vaccines have been given. The TGA has identified 11 reports where the cause of death was linked to vaccination from 769 reports received and reviewed. The deaths linked to vaccination occurred after the first dose of Vaxzevria (AstraZeneca) - 8 were thrombosis with thrombocytopenia syndrome (TTS) cases, 2 were linked to Guillain-Barre syndrome (GBS) and one was a case of immune thrombocytopenia (ITP).*"

- *There are many experienced, highly educated professionals who are being kept away from the profession that they invested many years training for. For example - doctors who took an oath to do no harm and teachers who were taught at university not to discriminate against students, however not they are being discriminated against - why? The mental health challenges the educators are experiencing are quite significant and impacts the education system.*
- What proof is there that there will be no long term effects of these vaccines?
- Those who want to be vaccinated can still choose to be vaccinated when the mandate is lifted as that is their freedom of choice.

So, please consider the above points and also those people who have had considerable impact on their holistic wellbeing due to the mandates - from people unable to see loved ones to people who are no longer working in the professions they love and invest years training for. People can make their own choices - please DO NOT extend the mandate.
