Good morning parliamentary committee,

I am writing today to express my strong objection to the extension of emergency powers. I believe this extension is completely unnecessary.

Of the approximate 270,000 covid deaths in Australia since the beginning of the pandemic, the ABS has recently released data showing that over a third of these deaths were from cancer. When removing comorbidities from the covid death rate, it appears that only around 2,700 deaths (a mere 1% of 'covid deaths') were caused by covid, in fact less deaths than a typical flu season.

The manipulation of covid case data is similiar, a friend this month went to hospital as she was in labour. Despite being completely asymptomatic she tested positive for covid and was therefore classified as a covid hospitalisation. This is ludicrous and highly misleading to the Australian public.

The vaccination mandates have failed to decrease covid cases since there introduction however have left thousands without work. I personally am without work for the first time in 25 years, despite loving my work with the department of education, even after I received a medical exemption and offered to work in distance education and remote communities. These mandates must stop, and no extension of emergency powers be granted!
