I DO NOT WANT an extension to the Emergency Bill until 31st October 2022.
These Emergency laws are no longer PROPORTIONATE.

- I have lost my income as a direct result of the current Emergency Bill. I am not even allowed on the premises of my workplace even though the clients don't have to be vaccinated.
- My 16 year old daughter will lose her income at the end of this month as a direct result of the Emergency Bill even though the customers she serves, don't have to be vaccinated.
- Segregation of our community, creating an underclass of people who don't have equal rights to participate in society has eventuated as a direct result of the current Emergency Bill.

Please DO NOT EXTEND THESE EMERGENCY LAWS because:

- In Australia I should be free to informed consent to medical treatment.
- In Australia I should have the freedom of conscience even in emergency.
- In Australia I should have equal rights.
- In Australia I should not be living in a segregated society.

With TESTING and APPROVED DRUGS FOR TREATING COVID-19, the extension of this Emergency Bill is NO LONGER PROPORTIONATE.

Even in wars there is provision for conscience.
Every history book warns against the division I am currently experiencing here in my home in Queensland, Australia.
People's bodies and conscience must be respected.
