Good Morning,

I am writing to voice my objection to parliament's bill to extend QLD's emergency powers. These powers need to end at the expiry of the current period (30 April 2022) - as a QLD constituent I strongly object to the extension.

The COVID-19 pandemic is over - most people are vaccinated, with much of the community also now having had and recovered from illness (as such there is significant natural immunity). There is no ongoing 'State of Emergency'.

This is an abuse of power to continue these Emergency Powers, they were never intended to continue on an indefinite rolling basis. We can manage COVID-19 as we do with seasonal flu or any other transmissible virus.

I also note that current mandates - vaccinated vs. unvaccinated for entry to certain premises etc also needs to be abolished. We are segregating our communities and destroying small business for no reason (there is no scientific or medical basis to continue these madates).

Please add this submission in support of ending these Emergency Powers in QLD on the 30th April 2022.
