To whom it may concern,

I am writing to you as I do not agree with the proposal to extend the Emergency Bill. I do not agree to the extension of the bill due to:

- 1. 99% who have had covid, have survived
- 2. When the boarders between NSW and Qld were opened and only vaccinated individuals were able to come into Queensland; our covid cases went from 0 -2 cases to over five thousand per day. From this it can be seen that the virus does not discriminate between individuals who are vaccinated or not.
