As a tax paying citizen of the Qld state of Australia I would like to express my concern over the proposal to extend the emergency bill.

I feel this is a gross overreach on the Governments behalf and it is totally unnecessary. The definition of emergency-

1. A serious situation or occurrence that happens unexpectedly and demands immediate action.

2. A condition of urgent need for action or assistance.

The situation we are in with regards to a virus, with a 99% recovery rate hardly constitutes an emergency.
