To whom it may concern, I write to indicate that I want this committee to decline any Extension to the Emergency Bill that is proposed for consideration.

The passage of time has provided data notably from the Australian Bureau of Statistics that indicates that the death rate predicted from the modelling used to implement the initial Emergency Bill was overinflated and thankfully far fewer lives have been lost. Therefore, an extension is not warranted and must not be granted.

The Emergency powers resulting from this initial Emergency Bill have caused discrimination, unnecessary anxiety and loss of income within the community and that is unacceptable in a democratic society.

The Government's own modelling suggests that Covid 19 has peaked as it has spread widely throughout the state inducing natural immunity, and in combination with the high vaccination rate would make any extension of the emergency powers blatantly unnecessary.
