I am writing to reject the Extension to the Emergency Bill.

New ABS Covid data is now showing us that emergency powers are not necessary and is a clear over reach of power.

My experience of your emergency powers from the past 2 years has been a significant loss of income, unable to see my family and recently the loss of my mother 69 years old due to the lack of care in her nursing home. My mother suffered staff shortages, delay in doctors visits and response times when needed for medical issues, continual shutdowns which caused depression, the inability of her family to get into care for her and lastly the mistakes that are made with no regard to consequences for my mother or other residents. A doctor literally came into my mothers home and gave her a 4th booster after mum had already told them she had already had the booster.... but because paper work wasn't done properly they doubled up her booster and my mum is now dead ! Only after my mother got sick did they check and found she had had one.

I will never forgive this government for my mothers death and I will never support the continuation of such a bill that will only cause more heartache for families like ours.
