I am emailing to advise that I **do not support** the Bill nor the extension of the state of emergency.

I found this presentation by Dr Peter McCullough very informative. He is a well-respected cardiologist, internist, epidemiologist and professor of medicine. Also, Dr McCullough has a master's degree in public health and is notably one of the top published researchers in the U.S. He has published many peer-reviewed academic papers on COVID-19. He has also successfully treated countless people with COVID-19 and has experienced COVID-19 himself. He spoke at a conference recently for Australian Health Practitioners. He presents academic research and discusses the importance of early treatment for COVID-19. He presents concerns and data on the poor safety profile of the mRNA vaccinations which have been mandated during the declared state of emergency. He also discusses masks and lockdowns. According to the research presented, 39% of COVID-19 is spread from vaccinated person to vaccinated person. This raises serious questions and concerns around the mandates that have been introduced during the declared state of emergency.
