I would like to express my concern for these emergency powers being extended.

The anxiety this has caused in the community is incredibly damaging and it cannot continue. All mandates, all measures must cease immediately.

My husband cannot finish his last year of a teaching degree as he is not allowed on school property without being forced to take a temporary and experimental vaccine.

We were unable to take our children anywhere over the Christmas school holidays as we choose to wait longer for more approvals of the vaccines. This caused me so much distress having to tell my children we can't even go to the zoo. All because of our private and personal medical choices.

My husband and I fall under the categories for being unable to wear a mask and we are absolutely exhausted from being judged, mocked and stared at. Our young children see this and it affects them greatly. The division is unacceptable and these measures feed in to the fear of covid which is proved to be no worse than the flu, especially the latest variant.

When my son had croup, diagnosed croup from a hospital, our family doctor refused to check him a few days later unless he got an invasive covid test. I refused, so he refused to check my son for pneumonia. As a parent I was livid. This treatment cannot continue.

This pandemic is over, vote accordingly.

If you believe in freedom for our nation and the rights of her peoples, end these emergency powers now.
