I am writing to ask that you say No to extending the state of emergency powers in Queensland until 2024 and restore the freedoms that Queenslanders once held before 2020.

It is ludicrous to think that because of the emergency powers that we have a two-tiered system in this state. I know personally how this has affected people's mental health and stress levels and good professional people who have lost their jobs due to these mandates. To think that these emergency powers have meant that people's livelihoods are at stake (such as their employment) and to have to make a choice between their jobs or to take a medical experiment.
