In light of the possible continuation of the state of emergency- SOE- in Queensland I wish to make a submission to end the SOE.

Queensland had ongoing SOEs for nearly two years due to Covid 19. Queensland policies had kept case numbers low until December 2021. This was achieved with lockdowns, mask mandates, blocking entry into the State of Queensland, hotel quarantine and vaccine mandates in many sectors of employment. Businesses not considered essential were forced to stay shut for months leading to business closures and loss of employment. The societal consequences were: rise in unemployment or very low hours of employment, extreme stress, mental health issues especially depression, anxiety, self harm and suicide. Loneliness in the elderly, pneumonia, mould infections and skin rashes due to mask wearing, increase in domestic violence and child abuse including sexual abuse of children. Loss of school education for nearly two years, developmental delay in young children. Furthermore, it led to a total erosion of the population's democratic and human rights and the accompanying loss of trust and confidence in our democratic institutions and leaders. All these efforts and fear mongering caused 0.9 % of deaths from or with Covid 19 nationally and a much lower percentage in Queensland. In fact, Australia wide a similar number of people died from suicide as died from/with Covid 19.

By early March 2022 most people vaccinated or unvaccinated had the latest strain of Corona virus - omicron. In other words: we have achieved herd immunity. Even though Queensland and other Australian states and territories have attempted to eradicate corona virus this proved impossible and always was impossible. The Australian people will pay the government debts incurred for decades to come. Many people lost their lives to the experimental vaccines, incurred permanent disabilities or health issues that will remain with them for the rest of their lives. This will affect individuals and their families as well as Australian society for decades to come.

May I also mention that Pfizer had to pay US\$ 2.3 billions in fines for fraudulently hiding the adverse health effects of their drug Bextra in off label use. AstraZeneca had to pay fines relating to promotion of off label use of Seroquel to the FDA: US\$ 520,000,000. AstraZeneca paid a further US\$ 647,000,000 in fines in over 28,000 lawsuits for failing to disclose that Serquel could cause diabetes. Complaints about vaccines usually center around fraudulent actions and hiding of serious side effects by pharmaceutical companies. The continuation of the SOE has no positive health effects as Covid 19 has run its course in the population. To continue the SOE further dismantles democracy and human rights in Australia and increases the disillusionment and distrust in our institutions.

The SOE needs to end now for Queenslanders to regain hope and confidence in life. Please do the right thing by all of us:

End the SOE.
