I oppose this extension on numerous grounds

- 1. True figures of COVID related deaths have not been made available and what has been reported has been distorted as can be seen by the recent ABS data.
- 2. Current restrictions have caused undue hardship on individuals, families, communities and businesses.
- 3. Current restrictions have also caused segregation and discrimination which I would have considered to be Un Australian and it breaks my heart to bear witness to this.
- 4. What has been lost is getting to the point of not being recoverable the loss to the economy but more importantly the level of anxiety in our children has not been never seen for many generations.
- 5. Wearing a mask of which the Science has never actually supported has had the impact of a huge increase in health issues specific to their use. In addition they are NOT fit-for-purpose!
