To Community Support and Services Committee.

Please do not recommend the extension of any of the Emergency response measures for Covid.

The information on which the initial Emergency was declared have been shown to be false.

There is no Health Emergency in Queensland or Australia.

The Covid 19 is not more infectious than a seasonal flu and for most of the community the risks of serious illness or death is about 0.01 % Only the elderly with Co morbidities are at significant risk from this disease and the injection of treatment does not stop infection or transmission.

There is currently no justification to prolong the emergency measures.

- The injections have huge databases of Adverse reactions.
- Children less than 12 yrs have much higher risk of damage from the Injection. Including Myocarditis , and Autoimmune diseases than from the Covid 19 due to their high natural immunity.
- Lockdowns and mask wearing had questionable efficacy initially but definitely can not be currently justified.
- Mandates are unethical and against the Human Rights agreements to which Australia is a signatory.
- Alternate treatments which have proved cheap and effective in multiple locations across the world must be made available immediately in Australia. The primary reason given for their ban was due to possible vaccine hesitancy. Since 90% of the population is injected already there is no justification for prolonging the ban under the emergency regulations.
