Dear Secretary ,

I write to object to a proposed extension to the above Subject Bill 2022.

It would seem that there is little need for and extension as the vaccinated and the unvaccinated can both be infected with Covid -19.

What is evident that whether one has two shots and a booster they can still catch Covid -19 eg our Prime Minster and Treasurer>

I would suggest that the figures produced as to the number vaccinated, be it 1 , 2, or 3 shots are totally inaccurate.

And as for the number of vaccinated who have caught Covid – 19 , any figures on those people would be speculative.

It would seem that most who have died from Covid -19 have been the vaccinated, and have a co morbidity problem.

The number of unvaccinated who appear as registered in the daily briefing run at about 12 percent of those infected.

If they pass away it is portrayed as being unvaccinated, yet they too may have had co-morbidity problems that are not disclosed.

The vaccines are only part effective as is evident by the number of shots required.

It would seem that the Legislation is more about panic in Government & Medical circles than about fact.

Any extension proposed would be more about further control of the population which is not required, we are not a Police State --- yet.

Again I write to object to an extension of the Public Health and other Legislation (Extension of Expiring Provisions) Amendments Bill 2022.
