To Whom It May Concern, I am writing to express my dismay at the Qld Government tabling a bill to extend to current Emergency Powers ( Public Health and other Legislation Extension of Expiring Provisions) until October 2022.

The extension of such a bill will be devastating to many, many families that have been unable to continue employment due to vaccine mandates. Myself and many others are convinced that mandates will not be revoked if the government continues to extend its emergency powers.

There is no need to extend the emergency powers. The Australian Bureau of Statistics show that less than 1% of the population have died from COVID...meanwhile heart disease, cancer and premature death from suicide have been leading causes of death. In fact COVID is 38th on the list of causes of deaths in Australia. Where has there been a concerted effort to promote healthy lifestyles throughout this pandemic?
