I am sending this submission to the Community Support and Service Committee in response to the introduction of the Public Health and Other Legislation (Extension of Expiring Provisions) Amendment Bill 2022 on 22 February 2022, that is currently under consideration.

I do not support this bill due to the following reasons:

- It is a violation of human rights
- It is not consistent with the Australian Constitution or the Magna Carta 1215
- It encourages discrimination and segregation
- Declaring a "State of Emergency" is an over reach of power as we do not have a state of emergency
- The classification of COVID-19 as a "pandemic" is based on inaccurate PCR tests which have been proven to provide false positives
- The actions over the last two years, and the extension of this bill, have severely impacted individuals and their families physically, financially, mentally, socially and emotionally and will continue to do so if this bill is passed
