RE: PUBLIC HEALTH AND OTHER LEGISLATION (EXTENSION OF EXPIRING PROVISIONS) AMENDMENT BILL 2022 (BILL)

I formally advise that I do not support the Bill nor the extension of the State of Emergency.

Queensland declared a state of emergency (SOE) on 29 January 2020. Extending it now from 30 April 2022 to 31 October 2022, means that Queenslanders will have been under a SOE for nearly three years.

If you actually read our submissions and take our information on board with a broad and balanced mind...rather than discard those of us out here who have now seen evidence and documentationeven on Government websitesyou may well have become aware that there is evidence

Indicating that the Deaths in Vaccinated now exceed the Deaths in the UnVaccinated
