I strongly object to any Extension of the Emergency Bill due to the prevalence of Omicron's very, very low mortality rate compared to the earlier variants- Delta and Alpha.

The **original** Emergency Bill was granted using evidence dependent on a **mortality rate** from the **Alpha and Delta** variants.

The case numbers have shown that the original modelling was considerably inflated.

The extension of powers is based on COVID deaths in Queensland and COVID numbers.
