Public Health and Other Legislation (Extension of Expiring Provisions) Amendment Act 2022)

4 March 2022

I am submitting this in order to confirm that I do not believe, nor do I consent to, the extension of these “Emergency Powers” by the Corporation, “The State of Queensland” to the living men and women, of the Commonwealth of Australia. I would also like to note that I was only made aware of this proposed extension, today, which does not give me much time to gather my thoughts and offer a detailed reply to the proposed extension and amendments. However, I object to any extension beyond the 30 April 2022 and do not consent to it. A few points -

- * In two years of living in “The State of Queensland”, under an apparent “pandemic” I have seen no evidence of such “pandemic” other than one created by the Government. An explosion of health problems caused by the experimental Covid 19 “vaccine” and the unlawful lockdowns and masking are the only pandemic I am aware of. From heart problems, blood clots, bleeding on the kidneys, unexplained issues, fatigue, asthma, enlarged lymph nodes, unexplained infections, strokes. mental health, loss of life - the list is extensive. The suggestion that we need to extend the bill is an overreach of monumental and unnecessary proportions. What happened to, “two weeks to flatten the spread?”.
- * The point made - *“Higher rates of vaccinations particularly in high risk settings also provide increased levels of protection for vulnerable cohorts in the community including the elderly and immunocompromised”*.(page 8) Where is the evidence that increased vaccination have provided increased levels of protection? If anything, increased rates of vaccination have seen increased rates of Covid.
- * Is it correct that the only way you can continue to administer Covid 19 “vaccines” is if an Emergency Bill is in place, thus the desire to extend it to beyond 30 April 2022?
- * A reminder from the Australian Human Rights Commission Act 1986, Article 7 -
No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment. In particular, no one shall be subjected without his free consent to medical or scientific experimentation.

Ultimately, the request to extend these powers are no longer relevant or necessary. As is happening in many parts of the world, people are learning to live with Covid and the extension of such powers will simply destroy more lives; physically, mentally, financially and medically. Men and woman of The Commonwealth of Australia are ready to move on and do not need the overreach of any governing body to inhibit just about every inalienable right we are bestowed with at birth.
