I wish to submit my response to the invitation to contribute to the citizens of Queensland, and as a taxpayer. I am employed and to meet living costs, I have a small business in the beauty industry.

I lost my business in Covid and wasn't eligible for any government funding and have struggled each week to pay my bills.

The original Emergency Bill was granted based on the death rate from the Alpha and Delta strains of the virus.

ABS data clearly shows that those original estimates were substantially overinflated.

My concerns as a parent and taxpayer are with the enormous costs that have crippled our economy and are significantly financially hurting everyday people like myself.

The extension of powers under the State of Emergency is based on COVID deaths in Qld and COVID numbers.

ABS data is now clearly demonstrating the gross exaggeration of this data. This critical information cannot be ignored any longer by anyone with the responsibility of making a decision on this committee and in parliament about the continuation of the State of Emergency until 31 October.
