I write to express my huge concern that parliament is currently considering an extension to the state of emergency under which QLD is working and living since the start of the Covid-19 Pandemic.

I note there have been many statements made of concerns and untruth, such as presenting the argument that current Covid is still dangerous and rife in our communities and the possibility of future strains being more serious.

There is a very clear trend around the world that we are all currently NOT in a pandemic anymore. Many countries have moved to endemic.
