The reason being

Therefore, I cannot apply for positions I am qualified to do. This instance has caused me to suffer severe financial hardship and placed me way below the poverty line, and my living standard has dramatically declined.

Therefore, I ask that the extension to the State of Emergency Bill be dropped and put an end to vaccine mandates. Thank you.
