Hi all,

I wish to add my voice to the very many other Queensland residents against the extension of the SOE. My reasons for this are quite simple.

1. There NEVER was a state of emergency however by declaring that it did indeed exist the Queensland Government were given far reaching powers they would not have ordinarily had. (For the first time in history there have been two years now of no winter flu season) There was no abnormal number of deaths, until the restrictions and the "Vaccinations" were introduced
2.
