Dear Committee Secretary,

I wish to formally advise that I do not support the Bill nor the extension of the state of emergency.

I feel my views are not being represented in the QLD Parliament

I ask the Committee to genuinely consider whether Queensland or indeed Australia, is still a liberal democracy if the people's elected representatives continue to ignore the will of their constituents, whilst supporting the continued suspension of democracy to the obvious and undeniable detriment of the people. When voting on this bill, I would urge you to consider that you are either helping deal a death blow to democracy, or helping protect it. I understand that any who vote in favour of further extending the state of emergency, is in fact voting for the continued suspension of democracy and that they have no acceptable reason to do so. Such representatives will be understood for what they actually are: traitors who have sold their constituents out for unmitigated power. Whereas before one could excuse a vote to extend the duration of the state of emergency because of the initial confusion, after two years, we are wiser and know better. There is no excuse. Any vote to continue this gross abuse of Queenslanders will be taken for what it is and all representatives in support will be held accountable. Make no mistake, the people are paying attention, and our memories are long. I hope the committee and its members come out on the right side of history and demonstrate the courage and leadership to.
